1 killed from Afghanistan, Angola, Azerbaijan, Democratic Republic of Congo, Indonesia, Kazakhstan, Kenya, Turkey, Uzbekistan, Mozambique, Paraguay, Burundi, Poland and Egypt.

2 killed from Ukraine, USA, Japan and Ghana.

3 killed from Guatemala.

4 killed from Colombia, Honduras and Pakistan.

5 killed from India and Libya.

6 killed from Brazil, Mexico and Somalia.
7 killed from France, Iraq,

Philippines, South Sudan and Yemen.
