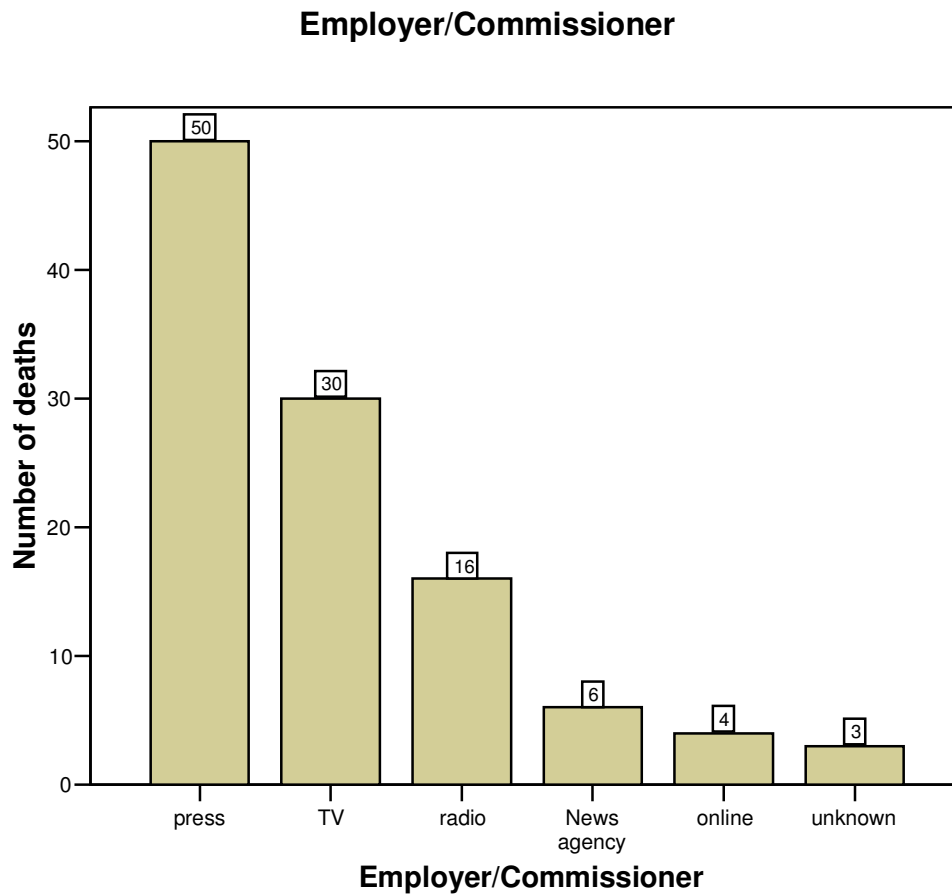

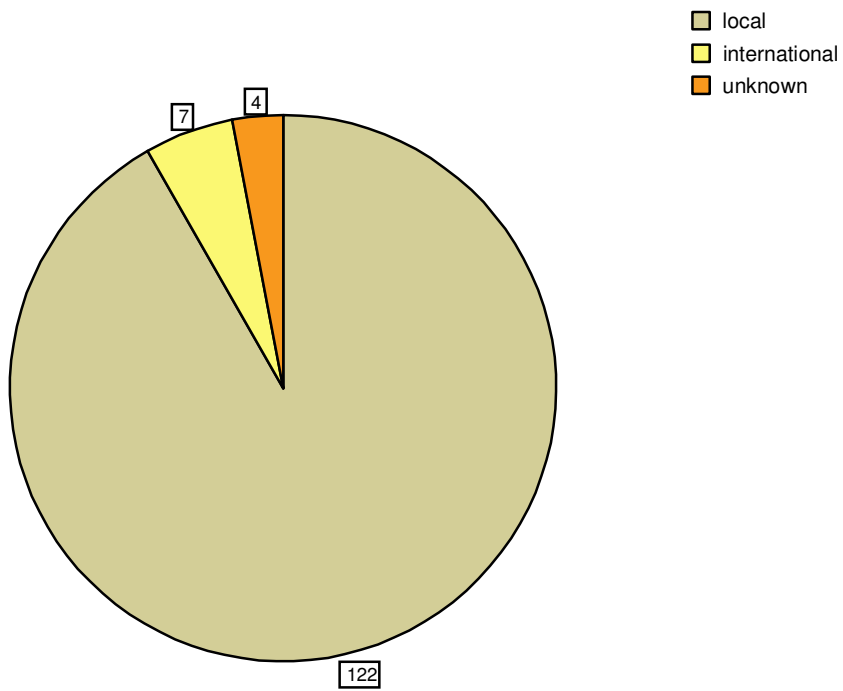

Professional Position

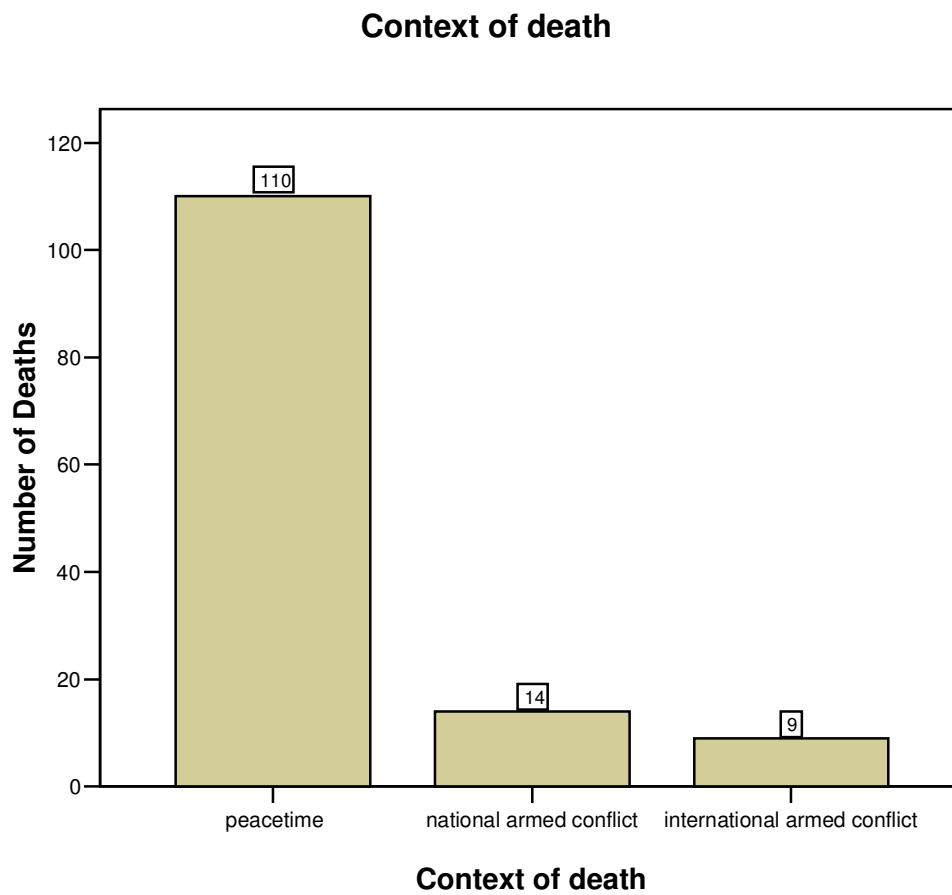

Status of journalist in country of death

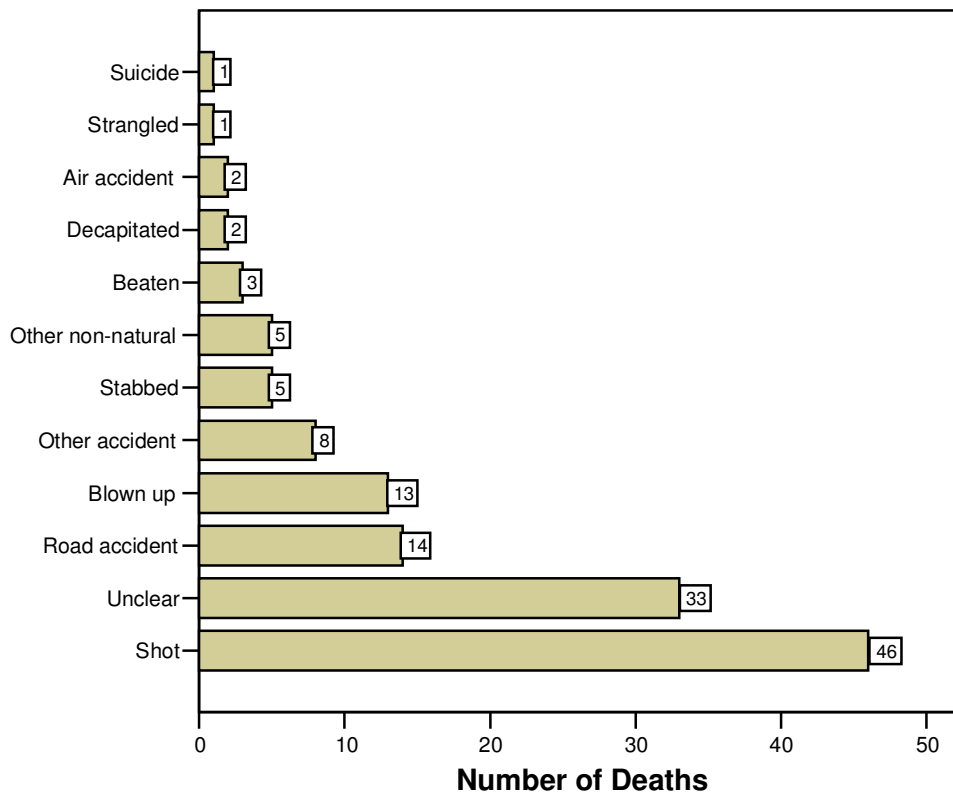

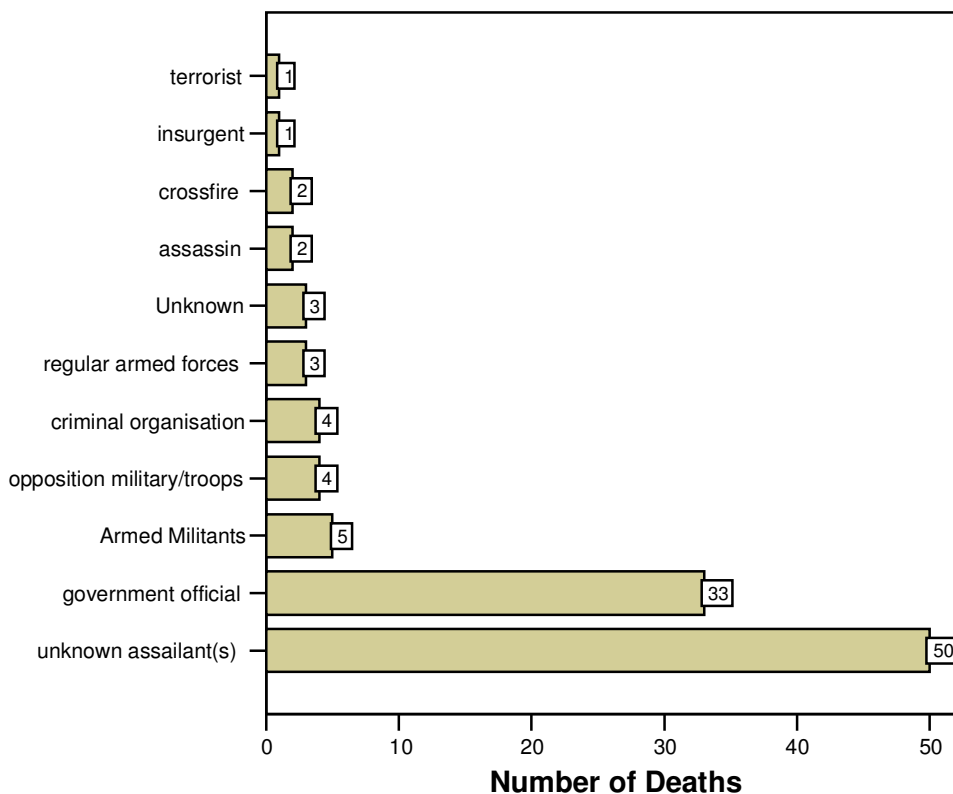

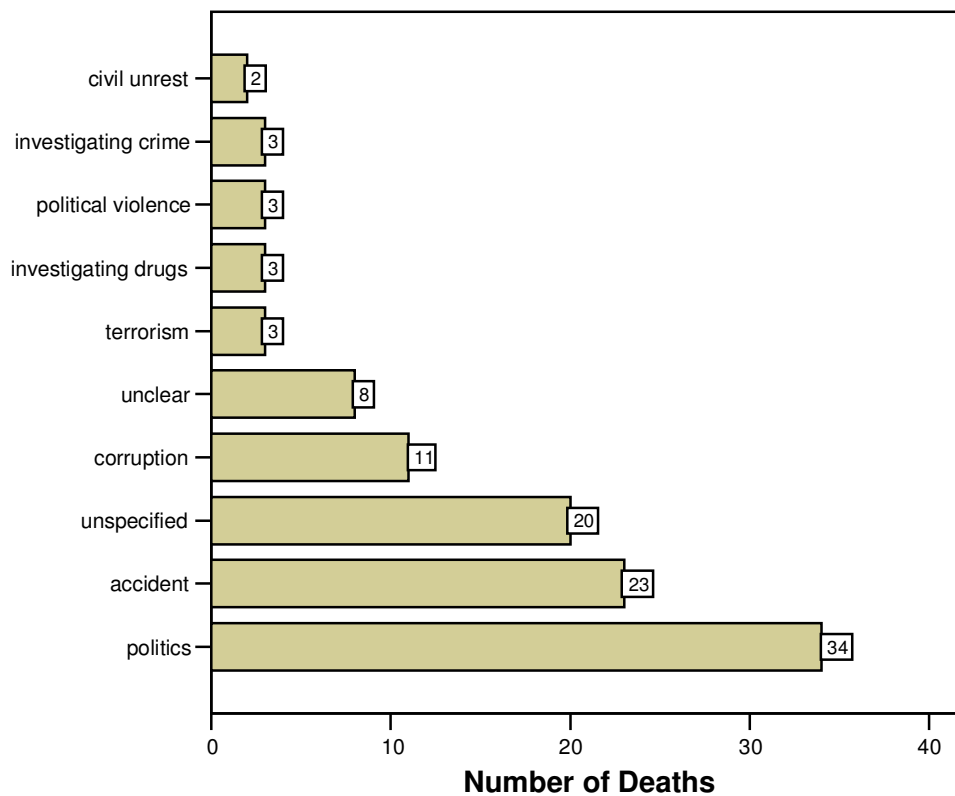

Deaths unrelated to war reporting

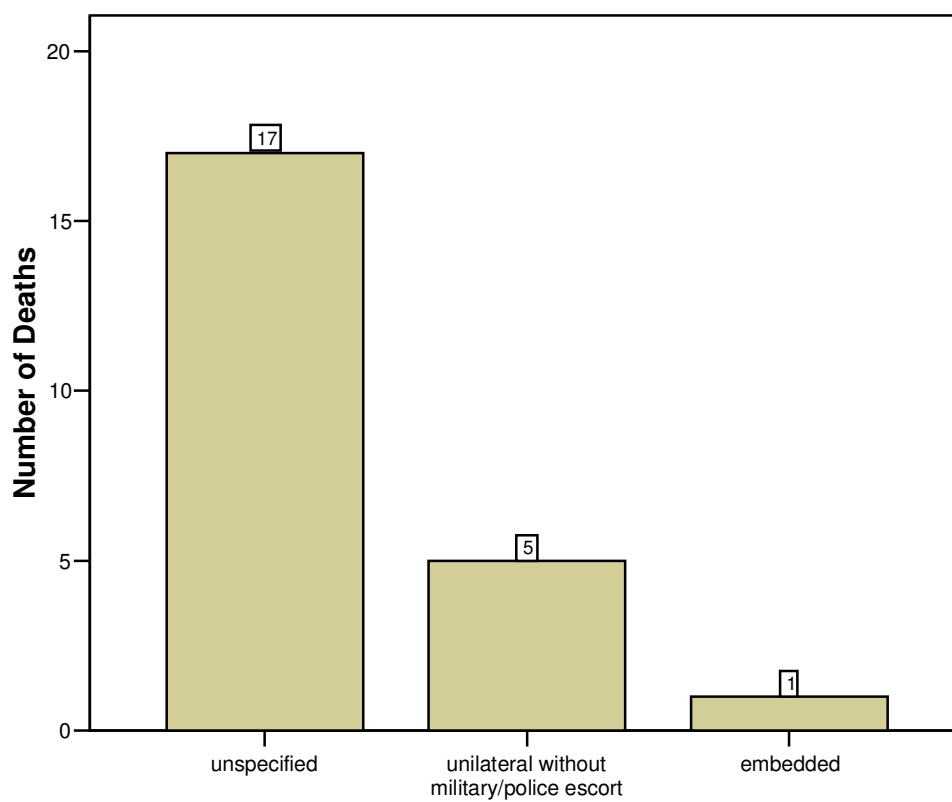

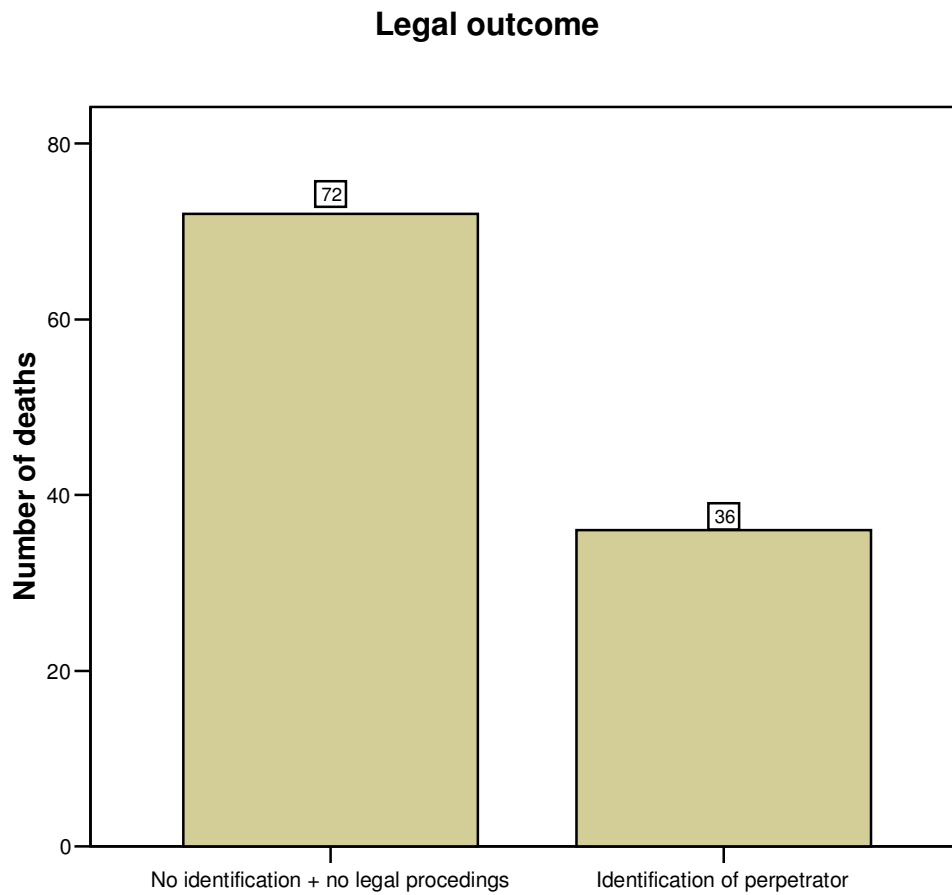
